Love Your Neighbour

Connecting younger and older neighbours for 121 friendship over the phone or in person, through weekly calls or home visits.

Social Clubs



Free group social activities, hosted in person, over the phone and on Zoom, where older and younger can get together to share experiences and meet new people. We host around 12-15 Social Clubs a month in various locations across Hackney and Tower Hamlets.



All Together activity packs

Free activity packs sent monthly (by post or email) which include an activity for every week of the month to do at home.



Support with technology skills

We aim to tackle the digital divide, by offering older neighbours support in accessing Zoom, email and other online social activities.

ADVICE FOR REFERRERS

We can accept referrals for people who are:

- Aged 65 or over
- Living in Tower Hamlets or Hackney
- Not living with a diagnosis of dementia, a psychotic disorder and/or any other unmanaged mental or physical health condition.
 - We consider a physical or mental health condition to be managed when the person living with the condition has adequate support in place and/or is on medication which helps them cope with their condition. Medication is not a necessity for their condition to be deemed as managed.

Other things to note:

- For tech support, we can help older people get set up on Zoom or email who already have an internet connection.
- We offer signposting support to older people who need help with practical issues such as grocery and prescription deliveries, housing and financial issues, or accessing local services.
